"The World's Nuclear Disasters", a symposium organized by Tetsuji Imanaka, a leading anti-nuclear scientist of the "Kumatori Group of Six" (Researcher, Kyoto University Research Reactor Institute (KURRI)) and Noriyuki Kawano (Director/Professor, IPSHU), was held on 12 November 2017 at the Seiryokaikan Hall, Tokyo. IPSHU hosted the symposium. Twelve speakers presented in-depth reports on the political and social status quo of the nuclear disasters in the Ural, Chernobyl, Semiparatinsk, and other regions. Over 250 participants attentively listened in the presentations and actively engaged in discussions. In the concluding session practical applications of the research outputs to the Fukushima nuclear disasters were considered.
