“Considering the Syrian Civil War, War on Terror, and Islam”

Professor Hidemitsu Kuroki, a leading scholar in Syrian Studies at the Research Institute for Languages and Cultures of Asia and Africa (ILCAA), Tokyo University of Foreign Studies (TUFS), gave a lecture for the 213th IPSHU Research Seminar on 31 October 2017. Professor Kuroki introduced the audience to the basic concepts of Islam and discussed in an accessible manner the current situation in Syria, the geopolitics of its Civil War, and the future challenges of the region. The lecture was followed by lively discussions. "There is no panacea for conflict resolution, but it is crucial to resolve small-scale conflicts step-by-step, or prevent them at an early stage", says Professor Kuroki. IPSHU will continue to explore these principles from the viewpoint of Hiroshima Peace Studies.
